CARRT's second community event featured a live demonstration of Ekso Bionic Suit for lower limb support. The event was held in RRT building on Wednesday June 11, 2014. This suit is a wearable bionic suit which enables individuals with any amount of lower extremity weakness to stand up and walk over ground with a natural, full weight bearing, reciprocal gait. It provides functional rehabilitation, over-ground gait training, and upright weight-bearing exercise unlike anything before. Various people with disabilities and community leaders attended the event and engaged in conversations about the suit and our ongoing research and collaborations.
